The petitioner has approached this court seeking issuance of a writ of quo-warranto against respondent No. 4 on the plea that at the time of seeking appointment on compassionate basis, he had submitted degree of B.A.-III (G) examination from Magad University Bodh-Gaya.

It is submitted that on verification from the University concerned, it was found that the name of respondent No. 4 was not registered against the number mentioned in the degree. For taking action against respondent No. 4 seeking appointment on the basis of a fake degree, the petitioner made a representation to respondent No. 2, but the same has not been responded to.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the submissions noticed above, in my opinion, the present petition can be disposed of at this stage, without opining on the merits of the controversy, with a direction to respondent No. 2 to take a final decision on the

representation made by the petitioner within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

Ordered accordingly.
