1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner retired from service on 31.1.2016 as a Safai Sewak from the Municipal Council, Batala (respondent No. 4 herein). Except GPF, the other retiral benefits have not been paid. She has also made a representation dated 5.6.2016 (Annexure-P-2) to the respondents, but no decision has been taken thereon so far. The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied if the Municipal Council, Batala, (respondent No. 4 herein) is directed to take a decision on her aforesaid representation.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the opposite party, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents, especially respondent No. 4, to take a decision on the representation dated 5.6.2016 (Annexure-P-2) regarding release of remaining retiral benefits of the petitioner within one month from the date

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of receipt of certified copy of this order and if it is found that the retiral benefits are payable, the same shall be paid within next one month alongwith the interest on account of the delayed payment, as admissible under the Government instructions. However, if the claim of the petitioner is denied, then a speaking order in this regard should be passed.

Disposed of.
