ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents to appoint her on the post of Constable in the Female Constable (General Duty) SC category.

It is the case of the petitioner that she has secured more marks than the last selected candidate in the Female Constable (General Duty) SC category and hence she deserves to be appointed.

In the reply filed by learned counsel for the respondents, it is stated that the petitioner had secured 33.65 marks out of 90 marks and the last candidate called for interview-cum-personality test had secured 35.50 marks in Female Constable (General Duty) SC category. The details of marks obtained by the petitioner are also set out in paragraph 5 of the written statement.

Therefore, as the petitioner has secured less marks than the last candidate called for interview in her category, this petition being devoid of merit, stands dismissed.
