The petitioner has preferred the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus directing the respondents to count the service period from 15.06.1987 to 12.10.1999 for the purpose of pension and pensionary benefits and to release the pension and pensionary benefits to the petitioner alongwith interest.

The short reply is already on record.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that as per para 6 of the short reply, service of the petitioner on daily-wages basis has been counted and all the benefits thereof have been released to the petitioner.

It being so, the present petition has become infructuous and is hereby disposed of accordingly.
