The petitioners seek direction to allow them to continue in service till the posts are filled up with regular incumbents. Further direction is sought for release of pending salary and honorarium and restraining the respondents from dispensing with their services.

A perusal of the orders (Annexure R-7 and R-8) would go to show that petitioner No.1 was relieved on 17.11.2011 whereas petitioner No.2 was relieved on 28.10.2011.

The petitioners approached this Court only thereafter when their services were already dispensed with. In the reply filed by the State, it has been specifically averred regarding that the honorarium, which had to be paid, has been paid against duly executed receipt to the tune of Rs.38,500/- and Rs.16,000/- respectively.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and accordingly, this petition is disposed of as such.
