MAHESH GROVER, J.

The only grievance of the petitioners is that even though they have filed an appeal along with an application for stay but the same have not been considered on account of the fact that the court was not held and they are continuously facing apprehension of being dispossessed in execution of the orders under appeal.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to the competent authority before whom the appeal is pending that he shall dispose of the application for stay in the first instance in case he is unable to decide the appeal within a period of two weeks from today.

It is made clear that the petitioners would not be granted liberty to take any adjournment in this regard.

Till that time or till the date when the application is decided status quo with regard to possession shall be maintained.
