RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK J. (ORAL)

Feeling aggrieved against the impugned election notice dated 24.10.2016 (Annexure P-4), whereby election is scheduled to be held today, i.e. 18.11.2016, petitioner has approached this Court by way of present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari, for quashing the impugned election notice.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Since the petitioner had sufficient time at his disposal from 24.10.2016, when the impugned election notice was issued, and he did not come to this Court immediately, for the reasons best known to him, present writ petition is wholly misconceived, at this point of time. It is so said, because now this Court has no time to call the other side to know their view point, as today itself is the date of election. So far as election programme is concerned, 7th November, 2016, was the date for filing nomination paper and now that material stage has also gone. Under these circumstances, no relief can be granted to the petitioner at the hands of this Court.

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No other argument was raised.

Considering the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case noted above, coupled with the reasons aforementioned, this Court is of the considered view that instant writ petition is wholly misconceived, bereft of merit and without any substance, thus, it must fail. No case for interference has been made out.

Resultantly, with the abovesaid observations made, present writ petition stands dismissed, however, with no order as to costs.
