It is not disputed that the petitioner has sat in the subsequent examination conducted by the respondent-Board. The grouse of the petitioner in the present writ petition was denial of taking the examination on the ground that he did not have the original of the IDs, which were Pan Card, Voter ID Card, Passport and Driving Licence. The petitioner was only carrying his Aadhar Card and, thus, was denied permission to sit in the examination.

As noticed he sat in the subsequent examination and has not been successful. The present writ petition has thus been rendered infructuous by sheer efflux of time and is disposed of accordingly.
