Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioner is at serial No.1 in the waiting list as the candidate, namely, Mukul Sharma, who was at serial No.1 in the merit list, has not joined and hence the petitioner is entitled to be appointed being at serial No.1 in the waiting list. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner has made a representation dated 19.07.2016 (Annexure P-3) but no action has been taken thereupon so far. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to decide the pending representation.

Keeping in view the limited prayer, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to consider the representation dated 19.07.2016 (Annexure P-3) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the petitioner is found to be entitled for the relief

sought for in the representation, the necessary exercise be done within a period of one month thereafter.

In case, the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.
