Affidavit of P. S. Aulakh, Registrar of the respondent-
University, dated 1.12.2015/20.1.2016 filed in court is taken on record.

The petitioner approached this court for extending affiliation to the petitioner-College for the session 2013-14. It was claimed that prior to that, the petitioner-college was affiliated with Panjab University, Chandigarh. As the requirement was that the University affiliating an Ayurvedic College should have a similar department in the University, the affiliation could not continue with the University. Under these circumstances, the petitioner sought affiliation with the respondent-University. For the session 2014-15 onwards, the petitioner was duly granted affiliation by the respondent-University, however, for the session 2013-14, there were certain problems being the transitional period, as upto the year 2012-13, the petitioner-college was affiliated with Panjab University. The petitioner-college is functioning from the year 1978 onwards.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that during interregnum, inspection was carried out. It has been so stated in the affidavit dated 1.12.2015/20.1.2016 filed by P. S. Aulakh, Registrar of the respondent-University. It has been stated that the petitioner has already been granted affiliation for the session 2013-14, hence, the prayer made in the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the respondent did not dispute the aforesaid factual position.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of as infructuous. Sum of ₹ 2,00,000/- deposited by the petitioner in this court in terms of interim order dated 16.12.2014 be refunded to it.
