The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to demolish the illegal construction over the property i.e. Shop No. 6 situated at Naulakha Cinema Road, Ludhiana.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the paper-book.

This Court cannot determine in the writ jurisdiction whether the construction raised is legal or illegal. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed, However, the petitioner will be at liberty to approach the concerned authorities for redressal of his grievance with regard to the alleged illegal construction.
