The challenge in this writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for setting aside the impugned notice dated 31.03.2014 (Annexure P2) under Section 148 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and impugned order dated 28.01.2015 (Annexure P9) passed by respondent No.1, rejecting the objections raised by the petitioner.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the initiation of reassessment proceedings, before the Appellate Authority, in case any adverse order is passed by the Assessing Authority in the reassessment proceedings.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to her in accordance with law.
