RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK J. (ORAL)

Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, the petitioner has approached this Court, by way of instant writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari/Mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, fairly states that he does not intend to press this writ petition qua the writ of Certiorari, for the time being. He submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioner was not being redressed by the respondent authorities, she finally approached respondent No.3 by way of legal notice dated 19.8.2016 (Annexure P-6), but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case the District Manager, Punjab Grains Procurement Corporation Limited (PUNGRAIN), Patiala- respondent No.3 is directed to consider and decide her legal notice, within a reasonable time.

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Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the District Manager, Punjab Grains Procurement Corporation Limited (PUNGRAIN), Patiala-respondent No.3 to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioner, raised vide her legal notice dated 19.8.2016 (Annexure P-6) and decide the same, at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
