RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court, by way of present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that statutory petition of the petitioner, at Annexure P-2 along with application for stay, is pending consideration before respondent No.1 for the last about three months but neither the matter has been heard so far nor any interim order has been passed, which is causing serious manifest injustice to the petitioner. He further submits that petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.1 is directed to consider and decide the petition of the petitioner at an early date and till the stay application is considered and decided, impugned suspension order (Annexure P-1) may be ordered to be kept in abeyance.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without

commenting anything on merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana-respondent No.1 to consider and decide the petition (Annexure P-2) along with stay application filed by the petitioner at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law.

However, keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case and also to ensure that statutory petition (Annexure P-2) may not be rendered infructuous by efflux of time in the absence of any interim order, it is directed that till the appropriate order is passed by respondent No.1 on the stay application moved by the petitioner, impugned suspension order (Annexure P-1) shall be kept in abeyance.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, instant writ petition stands disposed of.
