Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court, by way of present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioners was not being redressed, they finally approached the respondent authorities by way of self-contained representation dated 03.10.2016 (Annexure P-7) but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that petitioners may be permitted to supplement their already pending representation (Annexure P-7) by moving another comprehensive representation within a period of one week from today. Permission is granted. He also submits that petitioners will be satisfied in case respondent No.1 is directed to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-7) as well as the supplementary comprehensive representation to be filed by the petitioners

within a period of one week, within a reasonable time by passing an appropriate order.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, Superintending Canal Officer, Ferozepur Canal Circle, Canal Colony, Ferozepur-respondent No.1 is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance raised by the petitioners vide their representation dated 03.10.2016 (Annexure P-7) as well as the supplementary comprehensive representation to be filed by the petitioners within a period of one week and decide the same at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, instant writ petition stands disposed of.
