Case has been called twice, but none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the last date none was present.

The prayer is made to issue roll number for the examination which was proposed to be held on 08.12.2015. No interim order was passed in favour of the petitioner.

The defence of the respondent No.1 is that the petitioner had left the premises of the institute on her own free will and run away with Harpreet Singh on 27.08.2015. A notice was also issued regarding termination of her admission from the said institute and one week time was given to her father to report in the college. Her father appeared and stated that her daughter was not in his control and she had married Harpreet Singh without his consent.

In view of the above, it is apparent that the present writ petition

has been rendered infructuous. Even, counsel for the petitioner is not appearing for the last two occasions.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
