The petitioner seeks the release of entire pending admitted claims of grant in aid arrears, as detailed in para 10 of the writ petition and para 6 of the legal notice dated 27.11.2015 (Annexure P2).

It is the pleaded case of the petitioner-College that it revised the pay scales of its teaching staff w.e.f. 01.01.2006 and started paying revised grades to its teaching staff, as per UGC/Punjab Government notification dated 02.09.2009 but the respondents have not released the full grant amount and arrears. The details of the same have been given in para 10 of the writ petition.

Counsel submits that a legal notice dated 27.11.2015 (Annexure P2) has already been served and he would be satisfied if the same is decided within a time-bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr.R.S.Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copy of the paperbook has been supplied to him.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought, this Court does not feel it necessary to ask the respondents to file reply.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated 27.11.2015 (Annexure P2) of the petitioner-College. The authorized representative of the petitioner-College shall remain present in the office of the said respondent from 29.02.2016 to 02.03.2016, for supply of necessary documents. In case the petitioner-College is found entitled for the financial aid, same be paid within a period of 2 months from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the amount is to be denied, a speaking order be passed and the same be conveyed to the petitioner.
