MAHESH GROVER, J.

The only grievance raised by the petitioners in the instant petition is that even though their revision petition is pending before the competent authority, there is no restraint order to protect their possession which is now being seriously threatened by issuance of Annexures P-4 and P-5. It is stated that the matter is pending for 16.12.2016.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners and noticing the limited grievance raised before us, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition without issuance of notice to the other side but with a direction to the competent authority before whom the revision proceedings are pending to dispose of the same on 16.12.2016 itself. If for some reason the competent authority does not hold the court on 16.12.2016, he shall make endeavour to conclude the proceedings as early as possible but not later than January 2017. Ordered accordingly.

It is made clear that the petitioners shall not be granted any indulgence on account of unwarranted adjournments etc.

Till 16.12.2016 the parties shall maintain status quo with regard to possession.

If the matter is adjourned beyond that date, the interim order shall enure to the petitioners till the disposal of the proceedings which are expected to be finalised by the end of January 2017.

Petition stands disposed of.
