The prayer made in the present petition is for a direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to provide adequate security to the petitioner in view of threat from respondent No. 5, who is brother of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that dispute between the petitioner and respondent No. 5 is civil in nature regarding inheritance of the property. However, he fairly submitted that respondent No. 4 will examine the claim of the petitioner regarding threat perception and in case it is found that the petitioner requires any security, the same shall be provided.
