Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court, by way of present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari/mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioner , at the very outset, fairly states that he does not intend to press the present writ petition for a writ in the nature of certiorari, for the time being. He submits that although the petitioner is also seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, yet it did not approach the competent authority by moving an appropriate representation or legal notice, before filing the present writ petition. He further submits that given an opportunity, petitioner shall approach the competent authority by moving an appropriate representation within a period of two weeks from today.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights

of either of the parties, present writ petition is disposed of, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent authorities by moving an appropriate representation within a period of two weeks from today. The respondent authorities are directed to consider the grievance of the petitioner and take a final decision at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of representation from the petitioner.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, instant writ petition stands disposed of.
