Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Gulshan Sharma, Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar, submits that petitioner has been acquitted in one case, other case was disposed of after filing the cancellation report and in the third case, petitioner has been released on probation. He further submits that except the above-said three cases, no other case is pending against the petitioner as on date. He also submits that the State authorities would have no objection if respondent No.2 issues passport in favour of the petitioner.

In view of above, learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 3 fairly states that needful shall be done within a period of four weeks from today.

In view of the above-said respective stand taken on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and on behalf of respondent No.4, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2 to proceed further with the matter and issue the passport in favour of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today, however, strictly in accordance with law.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the instant writ petition stands disposed of.
