This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to cancel the tender of L-1 (Lowest bidder No.1) and to allot said work to the petitioner who is L-2 (lowest bidder No.2) as per policy of the Punjab Govt. of 2016-17, according to the condition (under clause No.20 and page 5 Schedule 16-17) under which for securing the said work the successful bidder i.e. lowest rate quoted by the contractor, the work was to be allotted to such contractor and the said contractor has to deposit security money through bank draft/deposit money in agency's account within two days after procuring the tender and was required to submit receipt of deposited amount failing which in the above said circumstances the next bidder deserves to get allotted said work.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with

liberty to take recourse to the remedies as available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
