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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioner retired from service on 30.11.2015 as Inspector from the Municipal Council Raman, Tehsil Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda, on attaining the age of superannuation. He claims that the retiral benefits have not been released so far. It is stated that no chargesheet or inquiry is pending against him. The petitioner has already made various representations (Annexure-P-2 Colly.) to the respondents, but to no avail.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, respondent No. 4 is directed to consider the representations of the petitioner (Annexure-P-2 Colly.) and if there is no impediment in the release of retiral dues, the same shall be released forthwith alongwith interest as per the Government instructions. However, if the Municipal Council, Raman, (respondent No. 4 herein) wants to deny the payment of retiral benefits, a speaking order shall be passed within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Disposed of accordingly.
