At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that similarly situated person, namely, Sukhwant Singh Gill, has approached this Court by way of filing ***CWP No.5188 of 2015***, which was disposed of with certain directions vide order dated 11.01.2016. He further submits that the petitioner is also similarly situated and hence, her case may be disposed of in the same terms.

Heard the arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner and have also perused the order passed in ***CWP No.5188 of 2015***.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 20.11.2015 (Annexure P-11) and in case, the petitioner is found to be entitled for the relief sought for, the same be granted to her within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, any adverse order is to be passed then reasons should also be recorded.

However, in case, still the petitioner is aggrieved by any action of the respondents, she is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
