DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of transfer order dated 15.11.2016 (Annexure P-4) qua to petitioner only passed by respondent No.2, vide which, the petitioner has been transferred from Rupnagar to Jalandhar against vacant post.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that order dated 27.9.2016 (Annexure P-3) is going to prejudice the rights of the petitioner due to partial modification done vide order dated 9.9.2016 (Annexure P-2), whereby, it has been directed that one Varinder Kumar Saini (respondent No.3) will draw his salary from Hoshiarpur Circle.

Heard the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner and have also perused the orders available on record. I have also

gone through the transfer order of respondent No.3 as well as of the petitioner.

The petitioner has been transferred from Rupnagar to Jalandhar vide order dated 15.11.2016 against the vacant post. The petitioner has alleged that order dated 27.9.2016 (Annexure P-3) is going to prejudice his rights due to partial modification done vide order dated 9.9.2016 (Annexure P-2), whereby, it has been directed that one Varinder Kumar Saini (respondent No.3) will draw his salary from Hoshiarpur Circle.

The petitioner is not going to be effected by order dated 27.9.2016 as he has been transferred from Rupnagar to Jalandhar vide order dated 15.11.2016 against the vacant post. There is no inter se connection between the petitioner and respondent No.3 and the petitioner has no concern with Hoshiarpur circle in any manner.

No ground is made out to interfere with the impugned order and the petition being devoid of any merit is hereby dismissed.
