After hearing learned counsel for the parties, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Principal Secretary, Department of Environment, Haryana-respondent No.1 to treat this writ petition as representation on behalf of the petitioner, look into the grievance raised by the petitioner in the present writ petition and take immediate remedial measures, by passing an appropriate order, at an early date, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
