DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that one Smt. Amarjit Kaur was also issued charge-sheet on the same allegations and was allowed voluntary retirement by considering her claim as per Government policy dated 24.6.2016. Subsequently a direction was issued by this Court in C.W.P. No. 2180 of 2016 to respondent to consider the case of the petitioner therein in view of guidelines framed in C.W.P. No. 25106 of 2015 titled as **Harinder Kaur Vs. State of Punjab and others** decided on 28.9.2016. Learned counsel further contends that the case of the petitioner is also at par with Amarjit Kaur and Harinder Kaur.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case directions are issued by this Court to consider the case of the petitioner in view of guidelines framed in C.W.P. No. 25106 of 2015.
