1. The petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to undertake a comprehensive survey of the entire Sri Guru Teg Bahadur Cooperative Housing Complex Sector-70, Mohali to identify unauthorized encroachment and constructions by the ground floor allottees on the Government land in Housing Complex like walls, gates on road breaches by erecting barbed wire fencing, which is common place as approved layout.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach respondent No.3 by filing a representation.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
