Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to move appropriate application before the Assistant Collector 2nd Grade/Ist Grade, as well as, before the concerned Patwari for entering a mutation on account of death of Mewa Singh as the succession has opened after his death. The petitioner also claims that he has a Will in his favour.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty. However, the petitioner will also be at liberty to claim his right on the basis of the Will which will be ultimately determined by the authorities in accordance with law. If the petitioner moves an application within one month from today, the revenue authorities shall take note of that and proceed in accordance with law.
