This order will dispose of two petitions bearing CWP Nos.25775 and 25790 of 2015 as common questions of law and facts are involved therein. However, facts have been extracted from CWP No. 25775 of 2015.

The prayer of the petitioner is for direction to the Maharshi Dayanand University (for short "the University") to grant no objection certificate. Direction has also been sought to National Council for Teacher Education (for short "the Council") to grant recognition to the petitioner-institute for B.A.B.Ed/ B.Sc.B.Ed and B.Ed. courses for the academic year 2016-17.

The issue was considered in detail in **CWP No. 17828 of 2015** titled as **OGIS Education Society Vs. Maharshi Dayanand University and another**, decided on 25.02.2016, wherein it transpired that out of total intake capacity of 60672 students in B.Ed. course in the session 2015-16, only 32811 seats could be filled up even after grant of extension for a period of four weeks. Hence, I do not find any reason to direct the authorities to consider the application of the petitioner for grant of permission to start integrated course of B.A. B.Ed/B.Sc. B.Ed. and B.Ed. courses for the academic year 2016-17.
