The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari/Mandamus to quash the letters regarding cancel of the tenders after accepting the bid of the petitioner (Annexure P-7) due to the malafide intension of the respondents No.5 to 7 and directing the respondents to issue the work order to the petitioner society immediately and also directing the respondents to be stopped from starting the process of inviting the same tenders again, the bid of which is already opened by the respondents and admitted in the name of the petitioner society.

2. After arguing for some time, when the Bench was not agreeing with learned counsel for the petitioner, he submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition.
