The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of prohibition restraining the Estate Officer from transferring the ownership of house No.3404, Sector 27-D, Chandigarh in the name of respondent Rubal Mantro during the pendency of application for restoration of suit which was dismissed in default on 08.08.2016.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedies available to him under Article 227 of the Constitution of India.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him in accordance with law.
