This petition is filed for seeking a *mandamus*, directing the official respondents to proceed against respondent No.4.

An inquiry was held against respondent No.4 by B.S.Sihag, General Manager of the Apex Society, allegations made against her have been proved but, thereafter, no action is being taken.

The petitioner is stated to have made a complaint through the Chief Minister Window and received the communication in which he has been informed that disciplinary action is being taken against respondent No.4.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and examining the available record, I am of the considered opinion that the information was supplied to the petitioner only in October, 2016 and the present petition has been filed just a month thereafter, without waiting at least for some reasonable time before the official respondents should take action against respondent No.4.

Consequently, the present petition is dismissed being premature.
