The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing order dated 30.05.2014 (Annexure P-9), passed by Tehsildar-cum-ACIG Nawanshahr and order dated 13.08.2015 (Annexure P-11), passed by Financial Commissioner Appeals-I, Punjab and further directing respondent No. 3 to pass a fresh order of partition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and perused the paper-book.

I do not find any illegality or perversity in the impugned orders. The petitioner should have challenged the mode of partition at the appropriate stage, which he did not do so and the partition was finalized. So far as the claim of the petitioner with regard to the electric motor for irrigation is concerned, he can agitate it before the civil Court, as revenue authorities have no power to partition the motor.

Dismissed.
