RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

The petitioners are aggrieved by order dated December 10, 2015 (P-1) vide which they have been transferred from the jurisdiction of respondent No.4 without any cogent and valid reason.

They have served a legal notice dated January 09, 2016 (P-3) to the authorities which is still pending with the decision-maker.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to decide upon the grievance/legal notice of the petitioners by treating this petition as a supplementary representation within a period of 7 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. The competent authority in making its decision would apply the law in **Shilpi Bose (Mrs.) v. State of Bihar**, AIR 1991 SC 532 and **Union of India and others v. S.L. Abbas**, 1995 (4) SCT 455.
