Twelve petitioners were aggrieved against the action of the Education Recruitment Board whereby they were being treated as ineligible for appointment as Social Studies Masters/Mistresses on the ground that they did not possess the B.Ed degree with the teaching subject of “Social Studies”.

It is contended that all the petitioners have secured their B.Ed degree with the teaching subject of a stream/discipline, which forms part of the subject combination for appointment as Social Studies teachers. It was further contended that the said teaching subject falls under the stream of “Social Science”.

Upon notice learned State Counsel and agreed upon by the

counsel for the petitioner that the present writ petition has become

infructuous as all the petitioners have been treated as eligible for appointment and would be offered appointment if they fall within the zone of appointment.

In view of the above, present writ petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
