Since the petitioner is having an equally efficacious alternative remedy of revision under Section 201 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994, which admittedly has not been availed by the petitioner before filing the present writ petition, she is relegated to her alternative remedy, at the first instance.

However, the revisional authority is directed that if the petitioner files an appropriate revision petition against the impugned order dated 21.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Ferozepur-respondent No.2, the revisional authority shall make every endeavour to decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law and in any case within a period of one month from the date of filing of the revision petition.

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It is also made clear that petitioner shall be liberty to move an appropriate stay application alongwith revision petition and the revisional authority shall consider the same without any further loss of time, by passing an appropriate interim order on such stay application.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
