The petitioner seeks the benefit of counting the *ad hoc* service rendered by him for the purposes of the pensionary benefits, in view of the Full Bench judgment of this court passed in ***'Kesar Chand Vs. State of Punjab and others' 1988 (5) SLR 27.***

It is the case of the petitioner that he was employed with the respondent-Board on *ad hoc* basis on 24.12.1986 and was regularized on 17.12.1991, and retired on 30.04.2015. The respondent-Board has not considered the abovesaid *ad hoc* period for the purposes of retiral benefits including pension.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that a representation dated 05.11.2015 (Annexure P-12) has already been moved for the said benefit. It is further pointed out that the said representation is still pending consideration and no decision has been taken.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pranav Chadha, Advocate appears on behalf of Mr. J.S. Puri, Advocate and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No.2. Copy of writ petition has been supplied to him.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied, if the representation dated 05.11.2015 (Annexure P-12) is decided within a time-bound frame.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought, this Court is of the opinion that reply is not required from the respondent-Board. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation dated 05.11.2015 within a period of 3 months.

In case the petitioner is held entitled for the necessary benefits, the same be paid to him within a period of 2 months, thereafter.

In case, an adverse order is passed, the same be conveyed to the petitioner.

With the abovesaid observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
