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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioner claims that he is entitled to benefit of five years' service for pensionary benefits under Rule 30 (5) of the General Insurance (Employees') Pension Scheme, 1995, in terms of parity with the decision of this Court in CWP-4071-2012, titled as Manpreet Singh Anand and others Versus Union of India and others, decided on 6.1.2016 (Annexure-P-3). The short prayer of the petitioner at this stage is that respondents may be directed to decide the legal notice dated 18.1.2016 (Annexure-P-2) after considering the judgment of this Court in Manpreet Singh Anand's case (supra) (Annexure-P-3) by passing a speaking order.

In these circumstances, as prayed for, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to decide the legal notice dated 18.1.2016 (Annexure-P-2) in view of the judgment of this Court in Manpreet Singh Anand's case (supra) (Annexure-P-3) by passing a speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this

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judgment.

Disposed of accordingly.
