Reply has been filed on behalf of Indian Red Cross Society in Court. The same is taken on record. In the notification dated 1.12.2008 (Annex. R-1) issued by the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Government of India in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 14 of the Administrative Tribunals, Act, 1985, inserted at Sr. No.190 of the Schedule the Indian Red Cross Society (IRCS) to fall within the jurisdiction of the Central Administrative Tribunal. The status of the Indian Red Cross Society has been recorded as “Statutory Autonomous Organisation under Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.”

In view of this disclosure, the petitioners are relegated to their remedy before the Central Administrative Tribunal exercising jurisdiction over the subject matter.
