Petitioner-Mandeep Singh was an applicant against the nineteen (19) posts of Assistant Professors in the Deptt. of Mechanical Engineering, meant for appointment in Giani Zail Singh Punjab Technical University Campus, Bathinda/respondent No. 7, advertised in November 2013 (**Annexure P-1**). The petitioner belongs to the category of Scheduled Caste, and five (05) posts out of the aforesaid total nineteen (19) posts were reserved for the said category. The petitioner was placed at Sr. No. 1 in the result of written test of Scheduled Caste Category against the five advertised/reserved posts. Thereafter, the petitioner also faced the interview conducted on 07.07.2014.

By filing the present writ petition, the petitioner is seeking a mandamus direction to respondent Nos. 3 to 7 for finalization of the selection process and issuance of appointment letters.

Although the notice of motion was issued vide order dated 17.12.2015, however, due to non-filing of the process fee, notices were not issued to the respondents-University. However, learned counsel for the respondents-University, appearing in connected CWP No. 11571 of 2015, submit that in the light of the facts mentioned in the said connected writ petition, no case for interference is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed for the reasons contained in CWP No. 11571 of 2015, titled *Hardeep Singh Versus State of Punjab and Others*.
