S.J.VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL):

1. The petitioner has made various allegations against respondent Nos.6 to 8. A report filed today pursuant to our order dated 4.2.2016, states that there are certain violations by the private respondents in respect of their premises. Seven violations have been mentioned. It further states that the private respondents have been stopped from carrying out any further work of addition or alteration. They have in fact given an undertaking not to do so. We only wish to clarify that we had not, by our order, restrained the private respondents from carrying out any construction. They would always be at liberty to carry out construction in accordance with law including by seeking permission, if necessary.

2. The official respondents states that they are unable to proceed with a show cause notice on account of a stay order having been granted in the petition, filed by the original allottee. Be that as it may, it is further stated that the show cause notice is now to be heard on 24.02.2016, and that action would be taken as per law depending upon the outcome of the hearing.

3. The petition is disposed of by recording the above statements and by directing the official respondents to complete the hearing of the show cause notice as early as possible and preferably by 31.05.2016 subject to any order restraining them from doing so. None of the respondents have any objection to the petitioners being heard in the proceeding related to the show cause notice.
