MAHESH GROVER.J.

The petitioner impugns the order dated 16.9.2015 by which the order of the Commissioner dated 26.9.2013 was upheld mandating a spot inspection before correction of Khasra Girdawri – a prayer made by the present private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that his objections were dismissed before the Assistant Collector which would cause a prejudice once the issue is finally decided regarding correction of Khasra Girdawri.

I am afraid the apprehension of the petitioners is unfounded. The Commissioner has very clearly stated that as on today there is no final order passed by the competent authority i.e. Asstt. Collector IInd Grade. The issue of determination has

been left dependent on the proceedings such as spot inspection etc. If that is so, then the report of spot inspection would form one of the basis to determine the correction of Khasra Girdawri apart from the relevant revenue record. If after spot inspection the petitioners have any objection to raise, evidently they would be at liberty to do so.

Petition dismissed.
