Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on 31.08.2015 i.e. at the time of the retirement of the petitioner an enquiry was pending against the petitioner due to which the retiral benefits of the petitioner were withheld. Now, vide order dated 19.09.2016, the petitioner has been exonerated. However, his pension as well as gratuity is not being released so far. The petitioner also claims interest on the delayed payment of GPF.

It comes out that the petitioner has already made a representation dated 04.07.2016 (*Annexure P-8*) followed by a reminder dated 10.11.2016 (*Annexure P-10*).

Now, the short prayer of the petitioner is that the respondents No. 2 to 4 may be directed to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 04.07.2016 (*Annexure P-8*) followed by a reminder dated 10.11.2016 (*Annexure P-10*) within a specific time frame.

In the circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents No. 2 to 4 to decide the aforementioned

representation of the petitioner dated 04.07.2016 (*Annexure P-8*) followed by the reminder dated 10.11.2016 (*Annexure P-10*) in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
