The petitioner seeks the relief of promotion from 26.11.1985, with all consequential benefits by amending the promotion order dated 02.01.1995.

It is the pleaded case of the petitioner that he had joined as a Class-IV employee on 18.03.1974 and thereafter, had passed the examination in May, 1997. The petitioner was promoted to the post of Senior Lab Attendant on 02.01.1995. It is the case of the petitioner that his juniors, seniority numbers of whom have been mentioned in the representation dated 08.08.2015 (Annexure P14), had been granted promotion from 26.11.1985 whereby the petitioners were promoted much later.

Counsel submits that in view of the pending representation dated 08.08.2015 (Annexure P14), he would be satisfied if the same is decided within a time-bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr.R.S.Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copy of the paperbook has been supplied to

him.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought, this Court does not feel it necessary to ask the respondents to file reply.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 08.08.2015 (Annexure P14), within a period of 3 months from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the benefits are to be denied, a speaking order be passed and the same be conveyed to the petitioner.
