The petitioner approached this Court seeking migration from Panjab University Regional Centre, Ludhiana to University Institute of Legal Studies, Panjab University, Chandigarh, in 7th Semester in B.A. LLB Five Years Integrated Course.

It is not in dispute that the University Institute of Legal Studies, Chandigarh and Regional Centre, Ludhiana are regulated by the Panjab University. The course curriculum is same and the examinations are also same. The petitioner sought migration in 7th Semester as it is permissible only in 3rd, 5th and 7th Semesters.

Learned counsel for the University submitted that 7th Semester is already over. The sanctioned strength of students is 120 plus 4 NRIs i.e. total 124 students. Though in 7th Semester 124 students were studying and had taken examinations, however, two students have been detained and have not been granted admission in 8th Semester. Consequently, the number of students studying in 8th Semester is 122 as against the sanctioned strength of 124.

No doubt, as per the Migration Rules, the migration can be granted in 7th Semester. In the present case, the petitioner has approached

this Court seeking migration in 7th Semester, which he has passed now. Once a seat is available in next semester, in my opinion, he deserves to be granted migration from Regional Centre Ludhiana to University Institute of Legal Studies, Panjab University, Chandigarh, in case the petitioner fulfills all other conditions required for migration. Let the needful be done within ten days.

The petition stands disposed of.
