RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK J. (ORAL)

Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court, by way of instant writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioner was not being redressed by the respondent authorities, he finally approached respondent No.3 by way of self contained representation dated 25.10.2016 (Annexure P-10) and respondent No.4 by way of representation dated 28.9.2016 (Annexure P-7), but the same are also pending decision. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondents No. 3 and 4 are directed to consider and decide his representations, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram-respondent No.3 and Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram-respondent No.4, to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioner, raised vide his representations dated 25.10.2016 (Annexure P-10) and 28.9.2016 (Annexure P-7), respectively, and decide the same, at an early date by passing an appropriate orders thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is further directed that while passing appropriate orders on the abovesaid representations of the petitioner, the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram-respondent No.3 shall keep in view the official communication (Annexure P-13), whereas the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram-respondent No.4 shall keep in view official communication dated 27.9.2016 (Annexure P-6).

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
