The petitioner is stated to have earlier worked as Extension Lecturer in Government College, Safidon.

It is the case of the petitioner that she deserves to continue as Extension Lecturer till regular appointments are made by the respondents and she should also not be relieved during summer/winter/examination period.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the judgment of a coordinate Bench of this Court in the case of “*Ms. Menka and others vs. State of Haryana and others*” in *CWP No. 9300 of 2015* decided on **05.05.2016**.

Learned State counsel contends that a coordinate Bench of this Court has issued directions pertaining to similarly situated persons while deciding *CWP No. 16975 of 2014*, in the case of “*Mrs. Rita Tandon vs. State of Haryana and others*”, decided on **29.07.2016** while

relying upon the judgment in the case of ***Ms. Menka and others vs. State of Haryana and others (supra)***.

At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner in the light of the judgments in the cases of ***Ms. Menka and others vs. State of Haryana and others (supra)*** and ***Mrs. Rita Tandon vs. State of Haryana and others (supra)*** in a time bound manner.

Therefore, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to treat this writ petition as a representation of the petitioner and consider and decide the same by passing a speaking order, keeping in view the judgments in the cases of ***Ms. Menka and others vs. State of Haryana and others (supra)*** and ***Mrs. Rita Tandon vs. State of Haryana and others (supra)***, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
