1. The prayer made in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 12.08.2016 (**Annexure P-4**) passed by the Technical Allotment Committee whereby earnest money deposited by the petitioner was ordered to be forfeited, without considering the material facts on record. Further prayer has also been made to direct respondent No.1 to conduct an enquiry as respondent No.6 in order to obtain the tender submitted forged and fabricated documents which can be ascertained from RTI reply dated 15.11.2016 (**Annexure P-7**) (colly.).

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that since certain questions of fact are required to be established by leading evidence, therefore, he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition. However, a prayer was made that

liberty be granted to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
