Petitioner-Ramandeep Singh was offered and appointed on compassionate basis as Salesman at 'The Sahpur Khurd CASS Ltd./respondent No. 4 on approval by the Registrar Cooperative Societies, Punjab, vide order dated 17.02.2009 (**Annexure P-1**). However, the Employer-Society denied the petitioner to join his service due to some alleged illegal activity.

It is averred that for some period in the year 2010, the petitioner was allowed to mark his presence. It transpires that the Society on 05.03.2011 passed a Resolution seeking to terminate the services of the petitioner, leading to passing of the impugned order dated 04.04.2011 (**Annexure P-5**). Hence, the present petition impugning the said termination order dated 04.04.2011 (**P-5**).

Since the last two dates, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to argue the case. Today also the position is same.

From the pleadings, it is apparent that a very vague petition has been filed, still further, the termination order has been challenged after a delay of more than five years which would be barred by law of limitation.

In view of above, no case for interference is made out, accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
